#### GAME NOTES

#### **All-Time Series**

This is the eighth all-time football meeting between UChicago and Illinois College. The Maroons lead the series 4-3 overall.

#### **Last Meeting**

In 2018, the Maroons routed the Blueboys 56-9. Quarterback Jeffrey Jackson completed 22 of his 31 passes for 234 yards and four touchdowns. He spread the ball around to 10 receivers, connecting with a different target on each score. The rushing attack produced 236 yards with an average of 6.1 yards per carry. Running back Vittorio Tricase led the charge with 92 yards, while running back Nicholas D'Ambrose ran for three touchdowns.

Defensively, nose tackle Jackson Ross snagged one interception, and forced and recovered a fumble. Cornerback Roberto Rabines snagged an interception of his own.

#### **Last Game**

In a game that came down to the final play at the goal line, UChicago lost 21-20 in overtime to Monmouth College last Saturday.

On a windy day, the run game proved most potent for both teams, as UChicago racked up 256 yards on the ground to Monmouth's 217. However, the Fighting Scots held almost a 15-minute advantage in possession time.

The game came down to the wire as both teams were able to score in overtime. UChicago's touchdown came second and the home team decided to go for the win with a two-point conversion. The Maroon receiver dove towards the goal line, but a defender jarred the ball loose. The referees ruled that the ball had not broken the plane, ending the contest in favor of Monmouth.

Junior running back Mike Martinson picked up 124 rushing yards on 15 carries (8.3 YPC). Sophomore wide receiver Caden Kalinowski scored two touchdowns, which came on a 27-yard reception and a seven-yard rush.

#### Athlete of the Week

Jackson Ross was picked as the University Athletic Association (UAA) Defensive Athlete of the Week on Monday. The junior defensive tackle collected a career-high 18 tackles versus Monmouth College. Ross kept his team close by blocking a pair of field goals from 45 and 46 yards out. He currently leads the Maroons with 71 tackles on the season. UChicago has now blocked five kicks this season.

#### **Ground and Pound**

The Maroons are averaging 225.7 rushing yards per game, which ranks second in the Midwest Conference and 28th in the nation. Their 5.5 yards per carry lead the MWC. The school record of 5.6 yards per carry was set in 1993.

Martinson's 6.9 yards per carry is the ninth-highest in NCAA Division III among qualifying runners. D'Ambrose is putting up 6.7 YPC and Tricase is averaging 7.7 YPC. The UChicago run game has scored 18 rushing touchdowns.

#### **Jack of All Trades**

Martinson is contributing 155.9 all-purpose yards per game, which ranks 23rd nationally. He has already broken the school record for punt return yards in a season with 351 (16.0 yards per return).

#### **Illinois College Notes**

The Blueboys are coming off a bye week. IC has shut down the opposition's passing game, ranking sixth in NCAA Division III in passing yards allowed per game (126.0). The punt return game has also been strong, ranking seventh nationally with 17.0 yards per return. Junior defensive lineman Jaylin Swan is currently second in the MWC with 13.5 tackles for loss and 6.5 sacks.
